- A Tie Tee is a T-shirt with a tie permanently attached to the neck.
- The tie features a fake knot that is removable for easier ironing.
- The tie is made from the same material as the T-shirt.
- Tie Tees are made with 100% organic cotton grown in Texas.
- Tie Tees are manufactured in Los Angeles, California.
- Tie Tees are available in both men and women's cuts, in six color contrasts:
  - *Business White with a Black Tie*
  - *Dynamite Red with a Black Tie*
  - *Medicinal Green with a Black Tie*
  - *Meltwater Blue with a White Tie*
  - *Harold Purple with a White Tie*
  - *Tuxedo Black with a White Tie*
